WHAT IS THE MENTORING CENTER?

The CJ mentoring center allows undergraduate students to **connect** with graduate students in Temple's Criminal Justice department.

CJ mentoring services include both assistance with **coursework** (e.g., help with assignments, study and reading tips) *and* **professional development** (e.g., graduate school advice, help with resumes).

We offer both in person *and* virtual meetings, dependent on your preferences and needs!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- 1. Fill out the **Google Form** (linked below), indicating what you would like assistance with and when you can meet.
- 2. A graduate student will be paired with you, depending on their expertise and ability to assist you, within 24-48 hours.
- 3. You will **receive an email** from the graduate student that you've been paired with, and you two will **schedule a time to meet**.
